PRACTICAL SHOOTERS CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Membership is required to participate. Members must pay annual dues of \$25.00. Dues are designed to cover the cost of equipment used by the club and administrative costs of the club. CASH ONLY.
2. Dues will be pro-rated **after** September 1st of each year for **new members only** and will then be \$15.00 for the remainder of the year. All memberships are for a calendar year, January 1 through December 31. Renewals are NOT eligible for the pro-rated amount. CASH ONLY.
3. Members must have, at minimum, completed the Kansas or Missouri Concealed Carry class successfully or possess a concealed carry permit. Each shooter will have to pass a safe gun handling assessment and briefing the first time they participate. Arrival by 12:45pm is necessary for your first time.
4. Members must check in at the beginning of each meet in the classroom and pay a shooting fee of \$15.00 to cover targets and pasters and rental of the facility. Upon check in they must display a current Bullet Hole membership card and current TMSA Practical Shooters Club membership card. They will then be issued a score sheet to enter the range area. CASH ONLY.
5. There will be two stages of fire available at each meet. Shooters may complete each course of fire multiple times providing time permits. Repeats will be allowed only after all registered shooters have had the opportunity to complete each stage at least once.
6. All members present will be required to participate in the set up and clean up of both stages at each meet.
7. There will be at least one Range Safety Officer in charge of each range.
8. Shooters must provide their own guns, ammunition and eye and ear protection and any other necessary shooting gear such as holsters and magazine pouches.
9. Only strong side hip holsters securely attached to a belt and that cover the trigger will be allowed. You must be able to properly and safely draw the gun from the holster to participate. IWB holsters will be allowed providing shooter shows the ability to use an IWB holster safely.
10. It is suggested that this practice be done with the gun that you carry.
11. Practice meets will be held one Sunday of each month beginning at 12:00noon and ending at 3:30pm. Check in will cease at 2:00pm. Anyone who wishes to shoot must be checked in no later than 2:00pm. See schedule on TMSA website.
12. No loaded firearms, concealed or otherwise, will be allowed in the classroom or on the ranges. Loading of all firearms will be done on the range at the direction of the Range Officer when it is your turn to shoot. Magazines can be loaded to capacity but no magazines in the gun. Any violation of this rule will result in permanent revocation of your membership. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
13. No magnum ammunition, guns over .45acp, single action revolvers or rimfire calibers are allowed. No race guns or race holsters are allowed. This is defensive shooting practice, not competition or bullseye shooting.
14. All annual membership dues and meet fees are payable only with cash. No checks or credit cards will be accepted for payment.
15. If you wish, you may come and watch one time to see how it runs and decide if you wish to participate. You must register as a guest in the classroom and be authorized to go onto the ranges as an observer.

RANGE PROCEDURES

1. Shooters may unload CCH guns upon entering The Bullet Hole, on the upstairs range. Just let one of the guys know you are going onto the range to unload. You may load again, same procedure, when leaving.

2. Check-in will take place in the classroom upon your arrival. Upon payment of fees you will be given a score sheet that allows you entry to the ranges. You may keep score if you wish but certainly do not have to do so. The score sheet is verification you are a current member and have paid your fees.
3. Shooters must have magazines and speed loaders loaded to capacity before entering the range area. This may be done in the classroom or before arriving at the facility. Shooters will holster their unloaded gun in the classroom. You may return to the classroom to reload magazines and speed loaders between stages or at any time you wish. Gear and bags may be left in the classroom while on the ranges.
4. Shooters will give the Range Officer their score sheet upon entering the range. Shooters will be called to the firing line in the order the score sheets are received. Be ready to shoot when your name is called. The Range Officer will tell you when you are on line (up next), on deck (next shooter), or in the hole (3rd out). Range Officers who are ready to shoot may cut in line so they can get back to their job.
5. The shooter on line will load when directed to do so by the Range Officer. They will be asked to “load and make ready”. This means to load the gun, chamber the first round and re-holster the gun.
6. The shooter will commence firing when the Range Officer issues the command to do so.
7. No guns are to be handled or out of the holster on the range unless you are the shooter on line and have been directed to load by the Range Officer. Any violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification and your membership will be revoked.
8. When you have completed the course of fire the Range Officer will ask you to unload and show clear. Unload the gun, lock the slide open or leave the cylinder open and allow the Range Officer to inspect. You may then re-holster the gun at the direction of the Range Officer.
9. Shots on targets will need to be pasted, steel and moving targets reset and brass swept or picked up before the next shooter comes on line. Everyone is expected to help with this task. Be sure that the shooter has had time to score their targets before pasting! Do not come forward to assist until the Range Officer has indicated the range is clear/safe. Shooters wishing to collect their brass may do so immediately after they finish shooting.
10. Any unsafe gun handling or breaking of safety rules will result in immediate disqualification and your membership will be revoked.
11. Remember, this is a practice session. This is NOT competition. There will be a variety of shooters with varying experience and skill levels. Please participate within that spirit!
12. Shooters who wish to learn to participate in scenario design are welcome and encouraged! Please advise Patti Stoneking if you wish to take part in this aspect of the club. All suggestions and positive input are welcome by club members.
13. Any command given by any Range Officer is to be adhered to strictly, no exceptions!
14. Each stage will require shooting anywhere between 20 and 40 rounds of ammunition.
